





Note: The following is only functional schematic, And the actual position and arrangement of different models may be different.






Press this button in standby mode to turn on / off the TV.

Terminal Interface



Install And Connect TV




Set your TV To put your TV in a firm place which can bear the weight of the TV.

To avoid danger, please don't expose the TV near water or heating place (such as light, candle, heating machine), do not block the ventilation at the back of TV.

Connect antenna and power 1.Connect the antenna cable to the antenna socket on the back of the TV.

2.To plug the power cord of TV. The attached power cord is for this model only Turn on TV

3. Connect the power supply, enter the standby mode (red light), press the power button of the TV or the power button on the remote control to turn on the TV.




The TV is packaged with the TV stand separated from the cabinet. To setup the TV table stand, please


carry out the installation according to the instructions below. 1. The panel can be scratched easily, so please:

Place a soft cloth on the table and place the TV face down on the cloth. Note: Always unplug the AC cord first when installing/removing the stand. 2. Take the base. Please align the screw holes of the base and the TV, and then insert the screws into

the holes on the base and tighten them. Note: To ensure that the TV is stable, please lock all screws. The stand of some TV models is designed with snap-in type, easily installed by snapping into stand groove, instead of screw.
